

## Certified Initial Coin Offering Professional (CICO)

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### Course Objectives

CICO enables the participants understand Cryptocurrency technologies to fund their development projects and understand the risks including legal aspects, when to use an Initial Coin Offering, and how the cryptocurrency market operates.

### Description

A Certified Initial Coin Offering Professional knows how to develop an Initial Coin Offering, and is familiar with the process of using an ICO to raise funds for starting, developing, or completing a startup's cryptocurrency- or blockchain-based software projects.

### Target Audience

The ideal CICO participant is familiar with raising capital, has worked with at least one programming language and has basic knowledge of Cryptocurrencies like Bitcoin, Ethereum etc.
